Below is a copy of DEFRA regulations which will apply to the "Home Counties Annual Show 2025 Canary Coloured Breeders Association - Home Counties Zone."

CONDTIONS FOR ENTRY OF BIRDS.

This show is held in strict accordance with the terms and conditions of the licence authorised by the Secretary of State.

(This licence permits the collection of birds at fairs, markets, shows exhibitions and other gatherings subject to the conditions set out in the schedule)

General licence conditions.

- 1. A record of all exhibitors and vendors will be kept for 3 months, and is to include the full name, home address and telephone number, plus number and type of birds. (as detailed on the entry form)
- 2. <u>Entry cannot be allowed</u> for any birds brought into the UK from any other EU country in the previous 4 weeks. There is an EU wide ban on the import of live birds from third countries already in place.
- 3. Bio-security information will be available.
- 4 **SALES OF BIRDS** through sale classes or sale tables is permitted subject to the conditions in paragraph 2 above.

Sales Transfer Forms will be available and must be completed and handed in to the door steward as a pass out for bought birds.

THESE FORMS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS THE REQUIRED INFORMATION IS COMPLETED FOR BOTH SELLER AND BUYER.

These records will be destroyed after the required period of 3 months.

Bio-security conditions.

All cages and carry boxes must be cleansed and disinfected before the show and should be repeated on return home and before use with any other bird.

Birds purchased at the show must be isolated for at least one week from other birds. Any signs of ill health observed in the purchased birds during this period must be reported to a veterinary surgeon and not mixed with any other birds until the presence of an avian notifiable disease has been ruled out.


